The Agni People, an Archeological View

Originally, the word Agni (Fire) referred to a system of logic, called Fire Logic, also known as "Infer Fire from Smoke:" Where there is Smoke there must be Fire. The Agni (Fire Logic) was invented in Syria. The people who believed in the Fire Logic were known as the Agni. The Agni were a subgroup of Syrians with their own distinct culture. The Agni people migrated east to India in search of a reliable source of perennial rainwater. Twenty thousand years ago, they established residence at the Mt. Trikuta of the Vindhyas, along the river Ken, to the west of the Chitrakuta range.

Idolatry was a Greek invention to rob people. The Greeks who occupied India after 200 CE, deliberately misinterpreted Agni (Fire) as a temple god of worship. They employed the delusional Kashmir Brahmin to deliberately vandalize all the Agni literature on logic to worship manuals of the fictional God Agni with supernatural powers.


The original Rig Veda was a treatise on Agni (Fire Logic), nothing to do with gods. The extant version of the Rig Veda is Greek rubbish, invented in Kashmir, by the delusional Kashmir Brahmin, financed by the Greeks, to destroy the Agni civilization.

What follows is an analysis of archeological evidence to trace the history of the Agni people.

Humans originated in Africa 200 thousand years ago. Sixty thousand years ago, some of them migrated out of Africa to occupy the rest of the world. At that time, much of world was covered with glaciers, and the seawater was 500 feet below the current levels. It was a different climate and landscape. The current Red Sea was a giant freshwater lake. The current Persian Gulf was the Tigris river valley. The West Coast of India extended over 100 miles into the then Arabian Sea, called the Indus Fan.

People who share the same DNA are called a Haplogroup. The people who left Africa sixty thousand years ago were the F group.

The F group reached the now submerged Tigris river valley and the Indus Fan forty thousand years ago. They lived along the blue line as shown in the map below. There the F was split into three different groups H, K, and J2 and spread out in different directions. The J2 went north, the H went south, and the K were in the middle. The L and H were siblings.



Twenty thousand years ago, the glaciers started to melt, and the blue line was submerged. People were forced to relocate. At that time, there was a giant catch basin of 300 miles long and 100 miles wide surrounding the Mt. Trikuta with inexhaustible rainwater to feed many rivers with perennial rainwater.


The H who lived along the Narmada delta moved to its headwaters, the Trikuta. The K moved to Iran. A subgroup of the K, the O, migrated further north to Bactria. From Bactria, they moved along the Himalayan ridge to reach the Trikuta. The J2 moved north to reach Syria and the Mediterranean Sea. A subgroup of the J2, the Agni (J2b), moved east to reach the Trikuta. The inexhaustible supply of rainwater at the Trikuta was the magnet that attracted the people.

Sun rituals were originally developed by the Syria civilization (J2), over thousands of years, to keep track of seasons. Agni rituals were a logical extension of Sun rituals. The Sun rituals, called the Direct Knowledge, were based on sensory Perception only. The Agni rituals invented the concept of Inference (Infer Fire from Smoke), a system of logical deduction. The Agni rituals were the Indirect Knowledge, based on deduction.

Around 2,200 BCE, also known as the 4.2 Kiloyear event, there was a global drought that lasted for almost two hundred years. The Trikuta basin dried out. The three civilizations (H, J2b, O) that lived at the Trikuta for thousands of years were forced to vacate to the east side of the Vindhyas. They fused into a new form of civilization known as the Hindu.

Before the global drought (2,200 BCE), the Agni (J2b) lived only on the west side of the Chitrakuta hills of the Vindhyas, along the Ken river. After the drought, they lived on the east side of the Vindhyas, mostly along the Ghaghara and Mahanadi rivers.

The Hindu (H, J2b, O) established a University along the Ghaghara river to teach logic. The original Rig Veda, Upanishads, Bhagavad Gita, and Agni Ramayana were composed by the Agni (J2b)



as textbooks on logic. The original Agni Ramayana was a compilation of Agni folktales to document the exodus, to vacate the Trikuta to move to the east side. It had nothing to do with the epic Ramayana. The extant version of the epic Ramayana was a fictional story invented by the Greeks to promote idolatry to exploit Rama as a temple god. The Greeks trashed the Rig Veda, Upanishads, and Gita as well.

The Hindu (H, J2b, O), that lived at the Trikuta for tens of thousands of years were logic-based civilizations; they never had the concept of God. The Greeks paid the delusional Brahmin in Kashmir to rewrite all the logic-based Hindu literature as worship manuals of fictional gods with supernatural powers. They actively promoted the recent Greek rubbish as the ancient sacred texts of the Hindu. Hindu were logic-based, they never had any sacred texts. They had only logic textbooks: nothing was sacred, all knowledge was subject to logical scrutiny.

The Hindu, on the east side of the Vindhyas, invented a new system of logic. They realized that knowledge was both subjective and objective. Subjective knowledge changed from person to person. It reflected bias and prejudices. Objective knowledge must be independent of bias and prejudices; all people, always, must reach the same conclusion.

The Hindu developed a system of reasoning to eliminate subjective knowledge. If a proposition (Hypothesis, Adhikarana) were rejected with verifiable facts, then it was objective knowledge. It would produce the same predictable outcome every time. An empirically rejected proposition was called Sabda. Sabda was Objective Knowledge.

Sabda was the equivalent of a present-day controlled experiment, that can be repeated with the same predictable outcome.

The original Rig Veda was a compilation of Objective Knowledge (Sabda). It was pure logic. It was invented at the Vindhyas, after 2,000 BCE, as a treatise on Objective Knowledge. The extant version of the Rig Veda is Greek rubbish, devoid of logic and reason. It was deliberately vandalized to promote idolatry.

The concept of Logic originated in Syria, as Sun Logic. It was developed to track seasons. It was based only on sensory perception. Sun Logic was Direct Knowledge (Perception, Pratyaksha).

The Agni (Fire Logic, Infer Fire from Smoke) was Indirect Knowledge (Inference, Anumana). It was a logical deduction.

An empirically rejected proposition (Sabda) always produced the same predictable result. It was a logical extension of deduction. It was invented at the Vindhyas. It was Objective Knowledge (Sabda).

The original Upanishads were Bhasya (commentary, interpretation) on the Agni (Fire Logic, Deduction). The extant versions of Upanishads are Greek rubbish, devoid of logic and reason. They are worship manuals of fictional gods with supernatural powers.

A new system of logic called Sankhya, based on Perception (Direct), Inference (Indirect), and Sabda (Objective) was invented. The original Bhagavad Gita (600 BCE), was an exposition of the new Sankhya system. It was a textbook on logic at the Hindu University. The extant version of the Gita is Greek rubbish, devoid of logic and reason.

The original Rig Veda was invented after 2,000 BCE, at the Vindhyas, as a treatise on logic. The original Upanishads were invented after 1,000 BCE, as commentaries on the Rig Veda. The Brahma Sutra was invented after 700 BCE, as a synthesis of the Upanishads. The original Bhagavad Gita was invented after 600 BCE, as a summary of the Hindu Scientific Method. They were treatises on logic, textbooks at the Hindu University. All of them were trashed to Greek rubbish, to promote idolatry.

It was the Greeks that destroyed the Hindu civilizations at the Vindhyas with idolatry. Kashmir Brahmin were the Greek mouthpieces. They never had any intellect or logic. They were delusional. They never had any ethics or morals. They vandalized all the Hindu literature for the Greek money. They were fiction writers for hire on the Greek

payroll. In India, before the Greeks, there was no archeological evidence of Brahmin, Gods, Temples, or Idolatry. The Greek rubbish was falsely attributed to antiquity.

Using scientific tools, we were able to excavate bits and pieces of the original textbooks on logic at the University. The excavated material has a different story to tell. What we have been able to excavate so far is the tip of the iceberg. It is a glimpse of the lost Hindu civilizations, that were deliberately and totally destroyed by the Greeks.

The Agni (J2b) were a subgroup of the Syria (J2) civilization. They invented the Agni (Fire Logic, Infer Fire from Smoke). They moved to the Trikuta when the Tigris valley was submerged. They moved to the east of the Vindhyas during the global drought. They documented their exodus from the west side to the east side of the Vindhyas in a series of Agni folktales.

The Hindu (H, J2b, O) were logic-based civilizations. The original Rig Veda, Upanishads, and Bhagavad Gita were textbooks on logic. They never had any sacred books. All knowledge was subject to logical scrutiny. They lived in peace and prosperity for tens of thousands of years. They were democratic republics with open borders. They were compassionate and respected other peoples' rights and property. They were subgroups of the F that left Africa sixty thousand years ago. They were an advanced logic-based civilization before they left Africa.

Unfortunately, the Hindu civilizations are now lost. Their textbooks on logic were reduced to Greek rubbish to promote idolatry. The recent Greek rubbish was actively promoted as the Hindu sacred texts of antiquity. The ancient civilizations were destroyed only recently after 200 CE. The archeological evidence has a different story to tell.
